




The presenters, Alexander von dem Bottlenberg (Berlin) and David W. Cline (Minneapolis, MN, USA) base their presentation on Frank Castorf's concept of "deconstructing the Ring".

Frank Castorf is one of Germany's most controversial contemporary directors and so is his interpretation of the Ring. Transferring the "Ring"-story into the history of the 20th century generally and then focusing on German history of the past 60 years (East /West and re-unification) he is using many hints and quotes that make his interpretation sometimes difficult to read for foreign (and even German) visitors. Hence his concept of directing almost refuses to offer just one way to read it.

In lectures/discussions lasting approximately 90 minutes, we will try to decode some of his hints and references to make the whole performance an enjoyable piece of modern theatre to you and proof that the Castorf "Ring" has unique significant meaning and implications for our present day culture.

Parsifal: The Will and Redemption



The presenter Dr. John L. Mastrogiovanni, (D.Min.) bases his presentation on his 2014 book "PARSIFAL: The Will and Redemption: Exploring Richard Wagner's Final Treatise" (available with amazon.com)

Wagner's concluding treatise to the world is contained in his final composition, Parsifal. Unique, compared to all his other works and yet a culmination of the expression of them. Lecturing on an aspect of his book, "Parsifal: The Will and Redemption," Dr. John, using Wagner's own words, opens the philosophical and spiritual concepts communicated. Originally confined to the Bayreuth Festival, "...there alone may 'Parsifal' be presented now and always: never shall Parsifal be offered in any other theater as an amusement for its audience..." (Wagner, September 28, 1880) Wagner very pointedly addressed Religion, the Age of Enlightenment and his convictions for the redemption of the human soul.
